Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Luke 6:43 "No good tree bears bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit. **44** Each tree is recognized by its own fruit. People do not pick figs from thornbushes, or grapes from briars. **45** The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in his heart, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in his heart. For out of the overflow of his heart his mouth speaks. - (NIV84)

Colossians 2:2 My purpose is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, - (NIV84)

Tuesday 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee the evil desires of youth, and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart. **23** Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels. **24** And the Lord's servant must not quarrel; instead, he must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. **25** Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, **26** and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will. - (NIV84)

Wednesday Nehemiah 2:11 I went to Jerusalem, and after staying there three days **12** I set out during the night with a few men. I had not told anyone what my God had put in my heart to do for Jerusalem. There were no mounts with me except the one I was riding on. - (NIV84)

Job 38:33 Do you know the laws of the heavens? Can you set up God's dominion over the earth? **34** "Can you raise your voice to the clouds and cover yourself with a flood of water? **35** Do you send the lightning bolts on their way? Do they report to you, 'Here we are'? **36** Who endowed the heart with wisdom or gave understanding to the mind? - (NIV84)

Thursday: Psalms 119:9 How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to your word. **10** I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands. **11** I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. - (NIV84)

Colossians 3:22 Slaves, obey your earthly masters in everything; and do it, not only when their eye is on you and to win their favor, but with sincerity of heart and reverence for the Lord. **23** Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, - (NIV84)

Friday: Romans 10:5 Moses describes in this way the righteousness that is by the law: "The man who does these things will live by them." **6** But the righteousness that is by faith says: "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?'" (that is, to bring Christ down) **7** "or 'Who will descend into the deep?'" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). **8** But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the word of faith we are proclaiming: **9** That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. - (NIV84)

Saturday: Psalms 51:10 Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. **11** Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. **12** Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me. - (NIV84)

Psalms 51:15 O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise. **16** You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; you do not take pleasure in burnt offerings. **17** The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise. - (NIV84)
