## Your Scripture for the Day

- Monday:** **Matthew 5:7** "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy. - (ESV)  
**Luke 6:35** But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return, and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, for he is kind to the ungrateful and the evil. **36** Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful. - (ESV)
- Tuesday** **1 Peter 1:3** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, **4** to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, **5** who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. - (ESV)  
**Romans 9:15** For he says to Moses, "I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion." **16** So then it depends not on human will or exertion, but on God, who has mercy. - (ESV)
- Wednesday** **Micah 6:6** "With what shall I come before the Lord, and bow myself before God on high? Shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves a year old? **7** Will the Lord be pleased with thousands of rams, with ten thousands of rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?" **8** He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? - (ESV)  
**Micah 7:18** Who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy. **19** You will again have compassion on us; you will tread our sins underfoot and hurl all our iniquities into the depths of the sea. **20** You will be true to Jacob, and show mercy to Abraham, as you pledged on oath to our fathers in days long ago. - (NIV84)
- Thursday:** **Psalms 25:4** Make me to know your ways, O Lord; teach me your paths. **5** Lead me in your truth and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation; for you I wait all the day long. **6** Remember your mercy, O Lord, and your steadfast love, for they have been from of old. **7** Remember not the sins of my youth or my transgressions; according to your steadfast love remember me, for the sake of your goodness, O Lord! **8** Good and upright is the Lord; therefore he instructs sinners in the way. **9** He leads the humble in what is right, and teaches the humble his way. **10** All the paths of the Lord are steadfast love and faithfulness, for those who keep his covenant and his testimonies. - (ESV)
- Friday:** **Romans 12:1** I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. **2** Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. - (ESV)  
**Hebrews 4:14** Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. **15** For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. **16** Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. - (ESV)
- Saturday:** **Psalms 130** A Song of Ascents. **1** Out of the depths I cry to you, O Lord! **2** O Lord, hear my voice! Let your ears be attentive to the voice of my pleas for mercy! **3** If you, O Lord, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand? **4** But with you there is forgiveness, that you may be feared. **5** I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in his word I hope; **6** my soul waits for the Lord more than watchmen for the morning, more than watchmen for the morning. **7** O Israel, hope in the Lord! For with the Lord there is steadfast love, and with him is plentiful redemption. - (ESV)
