## Your Scripture for the Day

**Monday: Ephesians 5:5** For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person—such a man is an idolater—has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. **6** Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient. **7** Therefore do not be partners with them. **8** For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light **9** (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) **10** and find out what pleases the Lord. **11** Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. - (NIV84)

**Tuesday Hebrews 4:12** For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. **13** Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account. - (NIV84)

**Matthew 4:4** Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'" - (NIV84)

**Wednesday Hebrews 6:17** When God wanted to guarantee his promises, he gave his word, a rock-solid guarantee— **18** God *can't* break his word. And because his word cannot change, the promise is likewise unchangeable. - (The Message)

**Deuteronomy 8:3** He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your fathers had known, to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord. - (NIV84)

**Thursday: Hebrews 3:7** So, as the Holy Spirit says: "Today, if you hear his voice, **8** do not harden your hearts as you did in the rebellion, during the time of testing in the desert, **9** where your fathers tested and tried me and for forty years saw what I did. **10** That is why I was angry with that generation, and I said, 'Their hearts are always going astray, and they have not known my ways.' **11** So I declared on oath in my anger, 'They shall never enter my rest.'" - (NIV84)

**Hebrews 5:11** We have much to say about this, but it is hard to explain because you are slow to learn. **12** In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food! **13** Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. **14** But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil. - (NIV84)

**Friday: James 1:4** Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. - (NIV84)

**John 1:11** He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. **12** Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God— **13** children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God. **14** The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. - (NIV84)

**Saturday: 1 Thessalonians 5:5** You are all sons of the light and sons of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness. **6** So then, let us not be like others, who are asleep, but let us be alert and self-controlled. - (NIV84)

**2 Corinthians 9:5** So I thought it necessary to urge the brothers to visit you in advance and finish the arrangements for the generous gift you had promised. Then it will be ready as a generous gift, not as one grudgingly given. **6** Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. - (NIV84)
