Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Acts 14:26 From Attalia they sailed back to Antioch, where they had been committed to the grace of God for the work they had now completed. **27** On arriving there, they gathered the church together and reported all that God had done through them and how he had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles. **28** And they stayed there a long time with the disciples. - (NIV84)

Acts 20:32 "Now I commit you to God and to the word of his grace, which can build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified. - (NIV84)

Tuesday Proverbs 1:8 Listen, my son, to your father's instruction and do not forsake your mother's teaching. **9** They will be a garland to grace your head and a chain to adorn your neck. - (NIV84)

Proverbs 3:21 My son, preserve sound judgment and discernment, do not let them out of your sight; **22** they will be life for you, an ornament to grace your neck. **23** Then you will go on your way in safety, and your foot will not stumble; **24** when you lie down, you will not be afraid; when you lie down, your sleep will be sweet. **25** Have no fear of sudden disaster or of the ruin that overtakes the wicked, **26** for the Lord will be your confidence and will keep your foot from being snared. - (NIV84)

Hebrews 13:9 Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings. It is good for our hearts to be strengthened by grace, not by ceremonial foods, which are of no value to those who eat them. - (NIV84)

Friday: Hebrews 12:14 Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord. **15** See to it that no one misses the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up to cause trouble and defile many. **16** See that no one is sexually immoral, or is godless like Esau, who for a single meal sold his inheritance rights as the oldest son. **17** Afterward, as you know, when he wanted to inherit this blessing, he was rejected. He could bring about no change of mind, though he sought the blessing with tears. - (NIV84)

Saturday: Luke 2:36 There was also a prophetess, Anna, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was very old; she had lived with her husband seven years after her marriage, **37** and then was a widow until she was eighty-four.
