**Your Scripture for the Day**

**Monday:** **Matthew 22:1** Jesus also told them other parables. He said, **2** "The Kingdom of Heaven can be illustrated by the story of a king who prepared a great wedding feast for his son. **3** When the banquet was ready, he sent his servants to notify those who were invited. But they all refused to come! **4** "So he sent other servants to tell them, 'The feast has been prepared. The bulls and fattened cattle have been killed, and everything is ready. Come to the banquet!' **5** But the guests he had invited ignored them and went their own way, one to his farm, another to his business. **6** Others seized his messengers and insulted them and killed them. **7** "The king was furious, and he sent out his army to destroy the murderers and burn their town. - (NLT)

**Tuesday** **Genesis 3:6** When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it. **7** Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made coverings for themselves. - (NIV)

**Genesis 3:21** The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them. - (NIV)

**Wednesday** **John 19:23** When the soldiers had crucified Jesus, they divided his clothes among the four of them. They also took his robe, but it was seamless, woven in one piece from top to bottom. **24** So they said, "Rather than tearing it apart, let's throw dice for it." This fulfilled the Scripture that says, "They divided my garments among themselves and threw dice for my clothing." So that is what they did. - (NLT)

**Thursday:** **Colossians 3:12** Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. **13** Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. **14** Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony. - (NLT)

**Matthew 17:1** Six days later Jesus took Peter and the two brothers, James and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. **2** As the men watched, Jesus' appearance was transformed so that his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light. - (NLT)

**Friday:** **Mark 5:25** A woman in the crowd had suffered for twelve years with constant bleeding. **26** She had suffered a great deal from many doctors, and over the years she had spent everything she had to pay them, but she had gotten no better. In fact, she had gotten worse. **27** She had heard about Jesus, so she came up behind him through the crowd and touched his robe. **28** For she thought to herself, "If I can just touch his robe, I will be healed." **29** Immediately the bleeding stopped, and she could feel in her body that she had been healed of her terrible condition. **30** Jesus realized at once that healing power had gone out from him, so he turned around in the crowd and asked, "Who touched my robe?" **31** His disciples said to him, "Look at this crowd pressing around you. How can you ask, 'Who touched me?'" **32** But he kept on looking around to see who had done it. **33** Then the frightened woman, trembling at the realization of what had happened to her, came and fell to her knees in front of him and told him what she had done. **34** And he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace. Your suffering is over." - (NLT)

**Saturday:** **Luke 15:20** "So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him. **21** His son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.' **22** "But his father said to the servants, 'Quick! Bring the finest robe in the house and put it on him. Get a ring for his finger and sandals for his feet. **23** And kill the calf we have been fattening. We must celebrate with a feast, **24** for this son of mine was dead and has now returned to life. He was lost, but now he is found.' So the party began. - (NLT)
