**Your Scripture for the Day**

**Monday: Luke 7:29** When they heard this, all the people—even the tax collectors—agreed that God's way was right, for they had been baptized by John. **30** But the Pharisees and experts in religious law rejected God's plan for them, for they had refused John's baptism. - (NLT)

**Proverbs 8:20** I walk in righteousness, in paths of justice. **21** Those who love me inherit wealth. I will fill their treasuries. - (NLT)

**Tuesday Galatians 6:7** Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. **8** The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. **9** Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. **10** Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers. - (NIV84)

**Wednesday Matthew 7:13** "You can enter God's Kingdom only through the narrow gate. The highway to hell is broad, and its gate is wide for the many who choose that way. **14** But the gateway to life is very narrow and the road is difficult, and only a few ever find it. **15** "Beware of false prophets who come disguised as harmless sheep but are really vicious wolves. **16** You can identify them by their fruit, that is, by the way they act. Can you pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? **17** A good tree produces good fruit, and a bad tree produces bad fruit. **18** A good tree can't produce bad fruit, and a bad tree can't produce good fruit. **19** So every tree that does not produce good fruit is chopped down and thrown into the fire. **20** Yes, just as you can identify a tree by its fruit, so you can identify people by their actions. - (NLT)

**Thursday: Matthew 7:21** "Not everyone who calls out to me, 'Lord! Lord!' will enter the Kingdom of Heaven. Only those who actually do the will of my Father in heaven will enter. **22** On judgment day many will say to me, 'Lord! Lord! We prophesied in your name and cast out demons in your name and performed many miracles in your name.' **23** But I will reply, 'I never knew you. Get away from me, you who break God's laws.' - (NLT)

**Friday: Matthew 19:16** Someone came to Jesus with this question: "Teacher, what good deed must I do to have eternal life?" **17** "Why ask me about what is good?" Jesus replied. "There is only One who is good. But to answer your question—if you want to receive eternal life, keep the commandments." **18** "Which ones?" the man asked. And Jesus replied: " 'You must not murder. You must not commit adultery. You must not steal. You must not testify falsely. **19** Honor your father and mother. Love your neighbor as yourself.'" **20** "I've obeyed all these commandments," the young man replied. "What else must I do?" **21** Jesus told him, "If you want to be perfect, go and sell all your possessions and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." **22** But when the young man heard this, he went away sad, for he had many possessions. - (NLT)

**Saturday: Luke 18:9** Then Jesus told this story to some who had great confidence in their own righteousness and scorned everyone else: **10** "Two men went to the Temple to pray. One was a Pharisee, and the other was a despised tax collector. **11** The Pharisee stood by himself and prayed this prayer: 'I thank you, God, that I am not a sinner like everyone else. For I don't cheat, I don't sin, and I don't commit adultery. I'm certainly not like that tax collector! **12** I fast twice a week, and I give you a tenth of my income.' **13** "But the tax collector stood at a distance and dared not even lift his eyes to heaven as he prayed. Instead, he beat his chest in sorrow, saying, 'O God, be merciful to me, for I am a sinner.' **14** I tell you, this sinner, not the Pharisee, returned home justified before God. For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted." - (NLT)
