Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: **Matthew 20:1** "For the kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire men to work in his vineyard. **2** He agreed to pay them a denarius for the day and sent them into his vineyard. **3** "About the third hour he went out and saw others standing in the marketplace doing nothing. **4** He told them, 'You also go and work in my vineyard, and I will pay you whatever is right.' **5** So they went. "He went out again about the sixth hour and the ninth hour and did the same thing. **6** About the eleventh hour he went out and found still others standing around. He asked them, 'Why have you been standing here all day long doing nothing?' **7** " 'Because no one has hired us,' they answered. "He said to them, 'You also go and work in my vineyard.' - (NIV84)

Tuesday **Matthew 20:8** "When evening came, the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Call the workers and pay them their wages, beginning with the last ones hired and going on to the first.' **9** "The workers who were hired about the eleventh hour came and each received a denarius. **10** So when those came who were hired first, they expected to receive more. But each one of them also received a denarius. **11** When they received it, they began to grumble against the landowner. **12** 'These men who were hired last worked only one hour,' they said, 'and you have made them equal to us who have borne the burden of the work and the heat of the day.' **13** "But he answered one of them, 'Friend, I am not being unfair to you. Didn't you agree to work for a denarius? **14** Take your pay and go. I want to give the man who was hired last the same as I gave you. **15** Don't I have the right to do what I want with my own money? Or are you envious because I am generous?' **16** "So the last will be first, and the first will be last." - (NIV84)

Wednesday **Matthew 6:19** "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. **20** But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. **21** For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. - (NIV84)

Thursday: **Romans 3:22** This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, **23** for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, **24** and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. **25** God presented him as a sacrifice of atonement, through faith in his blood. He did this to demonstrate his justice, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished— **26** he did it to demonstrate his justice at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus. - (NIV84)

Friday: **1 Corinthians 15:9** For I am the least of the apostles and do not even deserve to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. **10** But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect. No, I worked harder than all of them—yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me. - (NIV84)

Saturday: **Matthew 22:8** "Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding banquet is ready, but those I invited did not deserve to come. **9** Go to the street corners and invite to the banquet anyone you find.' **10** So the servants went out into the streets and gathered all the people they could find, both good and bad, and the wedding hall was filled with guests. **11** "But when the king came in to see the guests, he noticed a man there who was not wearing wedding clothes. **12** 'Friend,' he asked, 'how did you get in here without wedding clothes?' The man was speechless. **13** "Then the king told the attendants, 'Tie him hand and foot, and throw him outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.' **14** "For many are invited, but few are chosen." - (NIV84)
