Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: 1 Peter 4:1 Therefore, since Christ suffered in his body, arm yourselves also with the same attitude, because he who has suffered in his body is done with sin. **2** As a result, he does not live the rest of his earthly life for evil human desires, but rather for the will of God. **3** For you have spent enough time in the past doing what pagans choose to do—living in debauchery, lust, drunkenness, orgies, carousing and detestable idolatry. **4** They think it strange that you do not plunge with them into the same flood of dissipation, and they heap abuse on you. **5** But they will have to give account to him who is ready to judge the living and the dead. **6** For this is the reason the gospel was preached even to those who are now dead, so that they might be judged according to men in regard to the body, but live according to God in regard to the spirit. - (NIV84)

Tuesday 1 Kings 11:9 The Lord became angry with Solomon because his heart had turned away from the Lord, the God of Israel, who had appeared to him twice. **10** Although he had forbidden Solomon to follow other gods, Solomon did not keep the Lord's command. **11** So the Lord said to Solomon, "Since this is your attitude and you have not kept my covenant and my decrees, which I commanded you, I will most certainly tear the kingdom away from you and give it to one of your subordinates. - (NIV84)

Wednesday Numbers 14:20 Then the Lord said, "I will pardon them as you have requested. **21** But as surely as I live, and as surely as the earth is filled with the Lord's glory, **22** not one of these people will ever enter that land. They have all seen my glorious presence and the miraculous signs I performed both in Egypt and in the wilderness, but again and again they have tested me by refusing to listen to my voice. **23** They will never even see the land I swore to give their ancestors. None of those who have treated me with contempt will ever see it. **24** But my servant Caleb has a different attitude than the others have. He has remained loyal to me, so I will bring him into the land he explored. His descendants will possess their full share of that land. - (NLT)

Thursday: 1 Corinthians 2:13 When we tell you these things, we do not use words that come from human wisdom. Instead, we speak words given to us by the Spirit, using the Spirit's words to explain spiritual truths. **14** But people who aren't spiritual can't receive these truths from God's Spirit. It all sounds foolish to them and they can't understand it, for only those who are spiritual can understand what the Spirit means. **15** Those who are spiritual can evaluate all things, but they themselves cannot be evaluated by others. **16** For, "Who can know the Lord's thoughts? Who knows enough to teach him?" But we understand these things, for we have the mind of Christ. - (NLT)

Friday: Romans 14:17 For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of what we eat or drink, but of living a life of goodness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. **18** If you serve Christ with this attitude, you will please God, and others will approve of you, too. **19** So then, let us aim for harmony in the church and try to build each other up. - (NLT)

Matthew 22:35 One of them, an expert in religious law, tried to trap him with this question: **36** "Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?" **37** Jesus replied, "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind." **38** This is the first and greatest commandment. **39** A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' **40** The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments." - (NLT)

Saturday: 2 Corinthians 13:11 Dear brothers and sisters, I close my letter with these last words: Be joyful. Grow to maturity. Encourage each other. Live in harmony and peace. Then the God of love and peace will be with you. **12** Greet each other with a sacred kiss. **13** All of God's people here send you their greetings. **14** May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all. - (NLT)
