- Daniel 1:10 But he responded, "I am afraid of my lord the king, who has ordered Monday: that you eat this food and wine. If you become pale and thin compared to the other youths your age, I am afraid the king will have me beheaded." **11** Daniel spoke with the attendant who had been appointed by the chief of staff to look after Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah. 12 "Please test us for ten days on a diet of vegetables and water," Daniel said. 13 "At the end of the ten days, see how we look compared to the other young men who are eating the king's food.
