Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Isaiah 11:1 A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. **2** The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him— the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord— **3** and he will delight in the fear of the Lord. He will not judge by what he sees with his eyes, or decide by what he hears with his ears; **4** but with righteousness he will judge the needy, with justice he will give decisions for the poor of the earth. He will strike the earth with the rod of his mouth; with the breath of his lips he will slay the wicked. **5** Righteousness will be his belt and faithfulness the sash around his waist. - (NIV84)

Tuesday 1 Corinthians 2:7 No, we speak of God's secret wisdom, a wisdom that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory before time began. **8** None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. **9** However, as it is written: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him"— **10** but God has revealed it to us by his Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. - (NIV84)

Wednesday Colossians 3:12 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. **13** Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. **14** And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity. - (NIV84)

Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, O Israel, what does the Lord your God ask of you but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, **13** and to observe the Lord's commands and decrees that I am giving you today for your own good? - (NIV84)

Thursday: Psalms 33:13 From heaven the Lord looks down and sees all mankind; **14** from his dwelling place he watches all who live on earth— **15** he who forms the hearts of all, who considers everything they do. **16** No king is saved by the size of his army; no warrior escapes by his great strength. **17** A horse is a vain hope for deliverance; despite all its great strength it cannot save. **18** But the eyes of the Lord are on those who fear him, on those whose hope is in his unfailing love, **19** to deliver them from death and keep them alive in famine. **20** We wait in hope for the Lord; he is our help and our shield. **21** In him our hearts rejoice, for we trust in his holy name. **22** May your unfailing love rest upon us, O Lord, even as we put our hope in you. - (NIV84)

Friday: Psalms 103:11 For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him; **12** as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. **13** As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him; **14** for he knows how we are formed, he remembers that we are dust. **15** As for man, his days are like grass, he flourishes like a flower of the field; **16** the wind blows over it and it is gone, and its place remembers it no more. **17** But from everlasting to everlasting the Lord's love is with those who fear him, and his righteousness with their children's children— **18** with those who keep his covenant and remember to obey his precepts. - (NIV84)

Saturday: 1 Peter 5:5 Young men, in the same way be submissive to those who are older. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." **6** Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. **7** Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you. - (NIV84)

James 4:6 But he gives us more grace. That is why Scripture says: "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." **7** Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. **8** Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded. **9** Grieve, mourn and wail. Change your laughter to mourning and your joy to gloom. **10** Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up. - (NIV84)
