Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Ephesians 3:8 Though I am the least deserving of all God's people, he graciously gave me the privilege of telling the Gentiles about the endless treasures available to them in Christ. **9** I was chosen to explain to everyone this mysterious plan that God, the Creator of all things, had kept secret from the beginning. **10** God's purpose in all this was to use the church to display his wisdom in its rich variety to all the unseen rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. **11** This was his eternal plan, which he carried out through Christ Jesus our Lord. **12** Because of Christ and our faith in him, we can now come boldly and confidently into God's presence. - (NLT)

Tuesday Colossians 1:15 Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation, **16** for through him God created everything in the heavenly realms and on earth. He made the things we can see and the things we can't see— such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the unseen world. Everything was created through him and for him. - (NLT)

1 Corinthians 8:5 For even if there are so-called gods, whether in heaven or on earth (as indeed there are many "gods" and many "lords"), **6** yet for us there is but one God, the Father, from whom all things came and for whom we live; and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things came and through whom we live. - (NIV84)

Wednesday Job 36:22 "God is exalted in his power. Who is a teacher like him? **23** Who has prescribed his ways for him, or said to him, 'You have done wrong'? **24** Remember to extol his work, which men have praised in song. **25** All mankind has seen it; men gaze on it from afar. **26** How great is God—beyond our understanding! The number of his years is past finding out. **27** "He draws up the drops of water, which distill as rain to the streams; **28** the clouds pour down their moisture and abundant showers fall on mankind. **29** Who can understand how he spreads out the clouds, how he thunders from his pavilion? - (NIV84)

Proverbs 25:2 It is the glory of God to conceal a matter; to search out a matter is the glory of kings. - (NIV84)

Thursday: Isaiah 40:12 Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, or with the breadth of his hand marked off the heavens? Who has held the dust of the earth in a basket, or weighed the mountains on the scales and the hills in a balance? **13** Who has understood the mind of the Lord, or instructed him as his counselor? **14** Whom did the Lord consult to enlighten him, and who taught him the right way? Who was it that taught him knowledge or showed him the path of understanding? **15** Surely the nations are like a drop in a bucket; they are regarded as dust on the scales; he weighs the islands as though they were fine dust. - (NIV84)

Friday: Isaiah 40:28 Have you never heard? Have you never understood? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of all the earth. He never grows weak or weary. No one can measure the depths of his understanding. - (NLT)

Hebrews 2:10 God, for whom and through whom everything was made, chose to bring many children into glory. And it was only right that he should make Jesus, through his suffering, a perfect leader, fit to bring them into their salvation. **11** So now Jesus and the ones he makes holy have the same Father. That is why Jesus is not ashamed to call them his brothers and sisters. - (NLT)

Saturday: Psalms 36:6 Your righteousness is like the mighty mountains, your justice like the ocean depths. You care for people and animals alike, O Lord. **7** How precious is your unfailing love, O God! All humanity finds shelter in the shadow of your wings. **8** You feed them from the abundance of your own house, letting them drink from your river of delights. **9** For you are the fountain of life, the light by which we see. - (NLT)
