Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Psalms 2:1 Why do the nations conspire and the peoples plot in vain? **2** The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers gather together against the LORD and against his Anointed One. **3** "Let us break their chains," they say, "and throw off their fetters." **4** The One enthroned in heaven laughs; the Lord scoffs at them. **5** Then he rebukes them in his anger and terrifies them in his wrath, saying, **6** "I have installed my King on Zion, my holy hill." **7** I will proclaim the decree of the LORD: He said to me, "You are my Son; today I have become your Father. **8** Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession. **9** You will rule them with an iron scepter; you will dash them to pieces like pottery." **10** Therefore, you kings, be wise; be warned, you rulers of the earth. **11** Serve the LORD with fear and rejoice with trembling. **12** Kiss the Son, lest he be angry and you be destroyed in your way, for his wrath can flare up in a moment. Blessed are all who take refuge in him. - (NIV84)

Tuesday Isaiah 42:5 This is what God the Lord says— he who created the heavens and stretched them out, who spread out the earth and all that comes out of it, who gives breath to its people, and life to those who walk on it: **6** "I, the Lord, have called you in righteousness; I will take hold of your hand. I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people and a light for the Gentiles, **7** to open eyes that are blind, to free captives from prison and to release from the dungeon those who sit in darkness. **8** "I am the Lord; that is my name! I will not give my glory to another or my praise to idols. **9** See, the former things have taken place, and new things I declare; before they spring into being I announce them to you." - (NIV84)

Wednesday Jeremiah 10:6 No one is like you, O Lord; you are great, and your name is mighty in power. **7** Who should not revere you, O King of the nations? This is your due. Among all the wise men of the nations and in all their kingdoms, there is no one like you. **8** They are all senseless and foolish; they are taught by worthless wooden idols. **9** Hammered silver is brought from Tarshish and gold from Uphaz. What the craftsman and goldsmith have made is then dressed in blue and purple— all made by skilled workers. **10** But the Lord is the true God; he is the living God, the eternal King. When he is angry, the earth trembles; the nations cannot endure his wrath. **11** "Tell them this: 'These gods, who did not make the heavens and the earth, will perish from the earth and from under the heavens.'" - (NIV84)

Thursday: Revelation 15:2 And I saw what looked like a sea of glass mixed with fire and, standing beside the sea, those who had been victorious over the beast and his image and over the number of his name. They held harps given them by God **3** and sang the song of Moses the servant of God and the song of the Lamb: "Great and marvelous are your deeds, Lord God Almighty. Just and true are your ways, King of the ages. **4** Who will not fear you, O Lord, and bring glory to your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship before you, for your righteous acts have been revealed." - (NIV84)

Friday: Deuteronomy 32:7 Remember the days of old; consider the generations long past. Ask your father and he will tell you, your elders, and they will explain to you. **8** When the Most High gave the nations their inheritance, when he divided all mankind, he set up boundaries for the peoples according to the number of the sons of Israel. **9** For the Lord's portion is his people, Jacob his allotted inheritance. - (NIV84)

Saturday: Zechariah 8:20 This is what the Lord Almighty says: "Many peoples and the inhabitants of many cities will yet come, **21** and the inhabitants of one city will go to another and say, 'Let us go at once to entreat the Lord and seek the Lord Almighty. I myself am going.' **22** And many peoples and powerful nations will come to Jerusalem to seek the Lord Almighty and to entreat him." **23** This is what the Lord Almighty says: "In those days ten men from all languages and nations will take firm hold of one Jew by the hem of his robe and say, 'Let us go with you, because we have heard that God is with you.'" - (NIV84)
