### Your Scripture for the Day

**Monday: Romans 6:19** I am speaking in human terms, because of your natural limitations. For just as you once presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness leading to more lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness leading to sanctification. **20** For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. **21** But what fruit were you getting at that time from the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. **22** But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the fruit you get leads to sanctification and its end, eternal life. - (ESV)

**Tuesday 1 Corinthians 1:28** God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, **29** so that no human being might boast in the presence of God. **30** And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, **31** so that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord." - (ESV)

**2 Thessalonians 2:13** But we ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers beloved by the Lord, because God chose you as the firstfruits to be saved, through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth. **14** To this he called you through our gospel, so that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. **15** So then, brothers, stand firm and hold to the traditions that you were taught by us, either by our spoken word or by our letter. - (ESV)

**Wednesday Exodus 34:29** When Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the Testimony in his hands, he was not aware that his face was radiant because he had spoken with the Lord. **30** When Aaron and all the Israelites saw Moses, his face was radiant, and they were afraid to come near him. **31** But Moses called to them; so Aaron and all the leaders of the community came back to him, and he spoke to them. - (NIV84)

**Luke 9:28** About eight days after Jesus said this, he took Peter, John and James with him and went up onto a mountain to pray. **29** As he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became as bright as a flash of lightning. **30** Two men, Moses and Elijah, **31** appeared in glorious splendor, talking with Jesus. They spoke about his departure, which he was about to bring to fulfillment at Jerusalem. - (NIV84)

**Thursday: Hebrews 12:5** And you have forgotten that word of encouragement that addresses you as sons: "My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, 6 because the Lord disciplines those he loves, and he punishes everyone he accepts as a son." - (NIV84)

**1 Corinthians 11:31** But if we judged ourselves, we would not come under judgment. **32** When we are judged by the Lord, we are being disciplined so that we will not be condemned with the world. - (NIV84)

**Friday: Jeremiah 23:25** "I have heard what the prophets say who prophesy lies in my name. They say, 'I had a dream! I had a dream!' **26** How long will this continue in the hearts of these lying prophets, who prophesy the delusions of their own minds? **27** They think the dreams they tell one another will make my people forget my name, just as their fathers forgot my name through Baal worship. **28** Let the prophet who has a dream tell his dream, but let the one who has my word speak it faithfully. For what has straw to do with grain?" declares the Lord. **29** "Is not my word like fire," declares the Lord, "and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?" - (NIV84)

**Saturday: 1 Kings 6:7** In building the temple, only blocks dressed at the quarry were used, and no hammer, chisel or any other iron tool was heard at the temple site while it was being built. - (NIV84)

**Hebrews 4:11** Let us, therefore, make every effort to enter that rest, so that no one will fall by following their example of disobedience. **12** For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. **13** Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account. - (NIV84)
