Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Jeremiah 31:3 The Lord appeared to us in the past, saying: "I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with loving-kindness. - (NIV84)

Isaiah 51:1 "Listen to me, you who pursue righteousness and who seek the Lord: Look to the rock from which you were cut and to the quarry from which you were hewn; **2** look to Abraham, your father, and to Sarah, who gave you birth. When I called him he was but one, and I blessed him and made him many. **3** The Lord will surely comfort Zion and will look with compassion on all her ruins; he will make her deserts like Eden, her wastelands like the garden of the Lord. Joy and gladness will be found in her, thanksgiving and the sound of singing. **4** "Listen to me, my people; hear me, my nation: The law will go out from me; my justice will become a light to the nations. - (NIV84)

Tuesday 2 Corinthians 6:17 Therefore, come out from among unbelievers, and separate yourselves from them, says the Lord. Don't touch their filthy things, and I will welcome you. **18** And I will be your Father, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty." - (NLT)

Isaiah 61:8 "For I, the Lord, love justice; I hate robbery and iniquity. In my faithfulness I will reward them and make an everlasting covenant with them. - (NIV84)
