## Your Scripture for the Day

**Monday: Genesis 15:1** After this, the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision: "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your very great reward." **2** But Abram said, "O Sovereign Lord, what can you give me since I remain childless and the one who will inherit my estate is Eliezer of Damascus?" **3** And Abram said, "You have given me no children; so a servant in my household will be my heir." **4** Then the word of the Lord came to him: "This man will not be your heir, but a son coming from your own body will be your heir." **5** He took him outside and said, "Look up at the heavens and count the stars—if indeed you can count them." Then he said to him, "So shall your offspring be." **6** Abram believed the Lord, and he credited it to him as righteousness. **7** He also said to him, "I am the Lord, who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land to take possession of it." - (NIV84)

**Tuesday Exodus 13:17** When Pharaoh finally let the people go, God did not lead them along the main road that runs through Philistine territory, even though that was the shortest route to the Promised Land. God said, "If the people are faced with a battle, they might change their minds and return to Egypt." **18** So God led them in a roundabout way through the wilderness toward the Red Sea. Thus the Israelites left Egypt like an army ready for battle. - (NLT)

**Wednesday Joshua 1:6** "Be strong and courageous, for you are the one who will lead these people to possess all the land I swore to their ancestors I would give them. **7** Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the instructions Moses gave you. Do not deviate from them, turning either to the right or to the left. Then you will be successful in everything you do. **8** Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do. **9** This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." - (NLT)

**Thursday: John 21:15** After breakfast Jesus asked Simon Peter, "**Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?**" "Yes, Lord," Peter replied, "you know I love you." "**Then feed my lambs;**" Jesus told him. **16** Jesus repeated the question: "**Simon son of John, do you love me?**" "Yes, Lord," Peter said, "you know I love you." "**Then take care of my sheep,**" Jesus said. **17** A third time he asked him, "**Simon son of John, do you love me?**" Peter was hurt that Jesus asked the question a third time. He said, "Lord, you know everything. You know that I love you." Jesus said, "**Then feed my sheep. 18** **I tell you the truth, when you were young, you were able to do as you liked; you dressed yourself and went wherever you wanted to go. But when you are old, you will stretch out your hands, and others will dress you and take you where you don't want to go.**" **19** Jesus said this to let him know by what kind of death he would glorify God. Then Jesus told him, "**Follow me.**" - (NLT)

**Friday: 1 John 3:1** How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him. **2** Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known.
